1 Peter 4:7-11

This material is designed to help you hide God's Word in your heart and renew your mind. Most importantly we need to do the heart work that the Lord requires of all who hear His Word. Please read and meditate on the following daily passages and answer the following questions. *This will help prepare you for the lesson and discussion this coming Sunday.*

Day 1: Read 1 Peter 4:7-11

- How does the reality that Jesus could return at any moment change the way you approach prayer? What are some areas of your life where you need to become more intentional and purposeful in seeking God?
- What does it look like practically to love someone in a way that covers offenses instead of keeping score? Are there relationships where God may be calling you to forgive, extend grace, or pursue reconciliation?
- What gifts, abilities, or opportunities has God given you, and how are you currently using them for His glory?

Day 2: Read Matthew 24:42

- The Apostles believed Jesus would return any minute, what does "staying awake" mean to you and for your plans for the future?

Day 3: Read Romans Proverbs 10:12

- To whom and in what areas of your life do you need "a multitude of sins" covered?

Day 4: Read 1 Peter 5:1-5 (preparation for Sunday)
